June 19th - Arrive to Vancouver. Canada's thirdlargest city, Vancouver is a cosmopolitan place with a European feel and a personality all its own. Meet up with the group at the official hotel.

June 25th - Scenic cruising of Glacier Bay National Park. For many people, the highlight of an Alaskan cruise is a visit to a glacier. These natural formations are best viewed from the decks of a cruise ship or your own balcony, as you can get close to the action. June 26th - Scenic viewing of College Fjord. Harvard Glacier is the largest of the College Fjord Alaskan glaciers at its northwestern head, and it is the second-largest tidewater glacier in Prince William Sound.

June 27th - Arrival in Whitter. We will disembark the ship and board the Wilderness Express rail for our journey north. Direct-to-the-Wilderness rail service provides a fabulous beginning to an incredible journey, with magnificent scenery and friendly Princess service all along the way. You'll arrive refreshed for your very first night on land in Alaska at the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge.

June 28th - This morning, take an educational tour into Denali National Park. The views along the route from the Denali Lodge to our Mt. McKinley Princess Wilderness Lodge aboard our motorcoach are truly sensational. But the main attraction is the 20,310-foot mountain itself, visible from nearly anywhere on the lodge's property.

June 29th - Sit and gaze at the majesty of "The Great One" from the lodge's treehouse designed and built by Pete Nelson of Animal Planet's Treehouse Masters. The morning is free to either relax at the lodge or choose one of the many optional excursions. Continue by motorcoach to Anchorage for the night.
